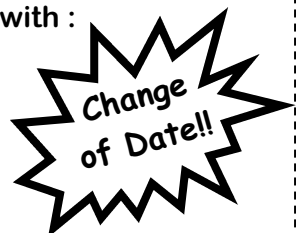

Ma-Na-Im campers went to New Roc City where they experienced glow-in-the-dark bowling, tons of arcade games and awesome bumper cars!

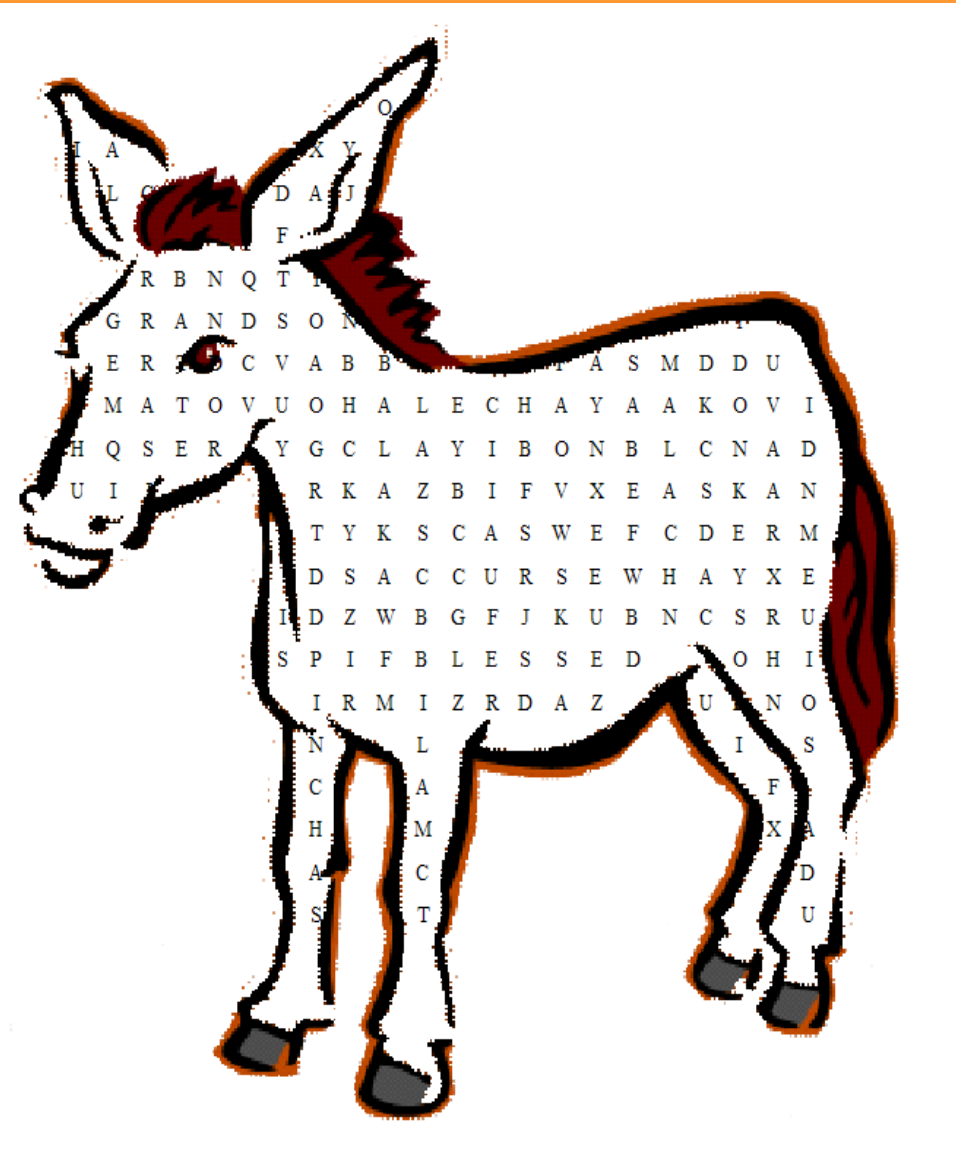
